ISO 19135-1:2015/Amd.1:2021 incorporates the provisions of the withdrawn ISO/TS 19135-2:2012 by way of a new Annex G which provides a link to an externally-held schema.”

#### *Introduction*

Delete “Annex C is particularly applicable to registers established under the auspices of ISO/TC 211.”

Insert before the last paragraph:

“Annex G describes XML implementation of this document.”
