Introduction

The safe use of floating leisure articles depends not only on the safety and reliability of the products in use but also on the adequate knowledge of the consumer/user about the risks related to water activities. The right information when selecting floating leisure articles is a further important aspect, as well as information on the correct device to use, performance that can be expected from the product or limitations to the use, and indications on the adequate behaviour on the water.

In particular, children need special supervision and care. Even if the products dealt with in the ISO 25649 series are only intended for use by swimmers, that does not at all eliminate the well-known risks that cannot technically be avoided because they depend more on behaviour than on performance.

This document deals therefore in particular with all aspects to inform the consumer/user before and during use about major risks and appropriate behaviour.
